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1. Opening Remarks by President.

The President presided over the Executive Committee Meeting. He welcomed all the EC Members present.

The EC resolved to confirm the Minutes of the EC Meeting held on 15.08.2025.

3. To approve the Statement of Receipts & Payments for the months of July 2025 and August 2025.

The EC resolved to approve the Statement of Receipts & Payments for the months of July 2025 and August 2025.

4. To approve the DCB for the months of July 2025 and August 2025.

The EC resolved to approve the Statement of DCB for the months of July 2025 and August 2025.

5. To discuss about the expenditure to be involved for the closure of existing ramp in the basement of the centenary building and other civil works.

The maintenance Sub-Committee scrutinized the quotations received for the closure of Ramp and other related civil works in the rear part of Basement of the Centenary Building. The maintenance Sub-Committee recommended the lowest quotation for the above work for approval. The Executive Committee resolved to approve the lowest rate quoted by the Hitech Civil Engineering Services (M) Private Limited for a value of Rs.4,99,494/- including GST and decided to issue work order to Hitech Civil Engineering Services (M) Private Limited.

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6. Ratification of the total expenditure incurred for the Coimbatore Medical Health Camp held on 16.08.2025.

The EC ratified the total expenditure of Rs.4,48,238/- (Four lakhs forty eight thousand two hundred and thirty eight only) incurred for the Coimbatore Medical Health Camp held on 16.08.2025 at Coimbatore, Total members attended the Medical Health Camp: Members: 131, Spouse: 91.

7. Any other subjects with the permission of the chair.

- (i) The EC ratified the Madurai Apollo Health Camp payment of Rs. 4,08,600/- (Four lakhs eight thousand and six hundred only)- Total Members attended the Madurai Medical Health Camp: Members:132, Spouse: 95
- (ii) The EC ratified the payment of Rs.146200/- to the Registration department of Government of Tamil Nadu towards the fee for declaration, Form 6, Form 7 and Form 7 penalty etc.
- (iii) The EC resolved to release the payment of 90% of the quoted value Rs. 25,85,640/- excluding GST to Hitech Civil Engineering Services (M) Private Limited as per the agreement after deducting TDS.
- (iv) The EC resolved to approve 5% hike in their monthly salaries to the staff and other temporary workers of IOA with effect from 01-10-2025.
- (v) The EC resolved to change the three existing Indian toilets in the fourth floor of the centenary building into western toilets for the convenience of Life members.
- (vi) The EC resolved to do whitewash on the walls of the basement of the centenary building and also flooring-painting work in order

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to utilize the basement for dining purpose in view of the forthcoming AGM on 20-9-2025.

- (vii) The EC wholeheartedly appreciated the Executive Committee Members Thiru V.Thamilselvam and Thiru. R.Pandiarajan for their commendable supervision of the concrete work done in the basement of the centenary building during the whole night of 27-8-2025. The EC commended their involvement and commitment shown in the interests of IOA.
- (viii) Mr. G.Prabhakaran, the tenant of the shop Nos. 114 and 115 has been refusing to enter into tenancy agreement since his occupation of the shops in the year 2020. However, he has been paying the monthly rent regularly without the 5% enhancement of the monthly rent levied for every 11 months. IOA has written many letters and served legal notice claiming the rental arrears in this regard. Now, the EC resolved to enter into an agreement with the tenant, as executed with other tenants, from 1st September, 2025.
- (ix) The EC ratified the payment of Rs. 386132/- to the Apollo Hospital, Tiruchy towards the health checkup undertaken by 133 members (Members: 71, Spouse: 62 at Apollo Hospital, Tiruchy).
- (x) The EC discussed about the preparatory work in respect of the forthcoming 118th AGM to be held on 20-9-2025.
