8. Review of court cases.

- (i) The suit in respect of O.S. No. 5478 of 2024 was decreed exparte (in favour of IOA) on 11-7-2025. Certified copies of judgment and decree are awaited.
- (ii) An settlement in respect of O.S.No. 6977 of 2022 has been arrived in the Mediation Court on 16-10-2025. The dependent has paid Rs.70,000 to IOA on 15-10-25 towards rental arrears and for the balance amount of Rs.2,91,204 to be paid to IOA, the dependent has issued post dated 6 cheques each for Rs. 48,534/-. In this way, the dependent will clear the rental arrears before 10-04-2026. Thus all disputes and differences in this




16. Any other subjects with the permission of the chair.
